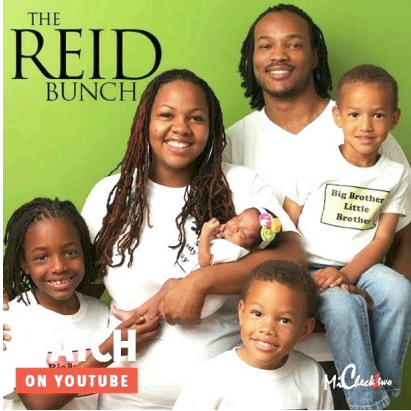


HUGUELY HAPPENINGS – JANUARY/FEBRUARY 2016
